

## California FFA State Scholarship Application Instructions 2022-2023

### Important Dates:

- Application Due Date: Tuesday, January 17, 2023 by 6:00 pm PST (8:00 pm CST)
- Finalists List Announced: Wednesday, February 15, 2023
- Interviews: Friday, March 17, 2023 during State FFA Leadership Conference

### New This Year:

- Application is now accessed and completed through student's AET account just like State & American Degrees, Proficiencies, Star Awards, etc.
- Student will select which scholarship they want to apply for.
  - Base Scholarships – one application puts student in the pool for the following:
    - Mabel Jacks Memorial Scholarship
    - Byron McMahon Memorial Scholarship
    - Bob Heuvel Memorial Scholarship
    - Dorothy & Richard McMillan Memorial Scholarship
    - Dean McNeilly Scholarship
    - Jaimie Lynne Pettey Memorial Scholarship
    - Past State Office State Officer 1992-93 Scholarship
  - Specific Scholarships – separate application needed for each of the following that the student wants to be considered for:
    - Dr. Jon Psaila Memorial Scholarship
    - Jerry Davis Memorial Scholarship
    - Paul Freitas Memorial Scholarship
    - Jerry Biggs Memorial Scholarship
    - Universal Technical Institute Scholarship
    - Almond Board of CA Scholarship
    - Zenith Insurance Scholarship
- Students can apply for multiple scholarships.
  - To do so, they need to create separate applications. *It is recommended to save the essay responses to a document so they can be easily cut & pasted into each new application.*
  - While a student may apply for multiple scholarships, they may only be considered as a finalist for one scholarship.
- Students will need to upload the following documents:
  - Photo in FFA Official Dress
  - Transcript from your most recent school showing your G.P.A. (*upload to resume section of AET records*)
  - 1 letter of recommendation from a teacher, administrator, employer or non-family member (*upload to resume section of AET records*)

### How to Submit Completed Applications:

1. Have student complete application on their AET account. Hit "save/print" to create a PDF of the application.
2. Teacher will log into chapter AET account.
3. Click on "Reports"
4. Click on "Degree/Application Manager"
5. Click on green "Submission Lists & Feedback" button
6. Scroll down to the CA State Scholarship Application section
7. Click gray "Edit List" button
8. Click "Browse" button to see list of available applications
9. Add the scholarship application(s) that you want to submit
